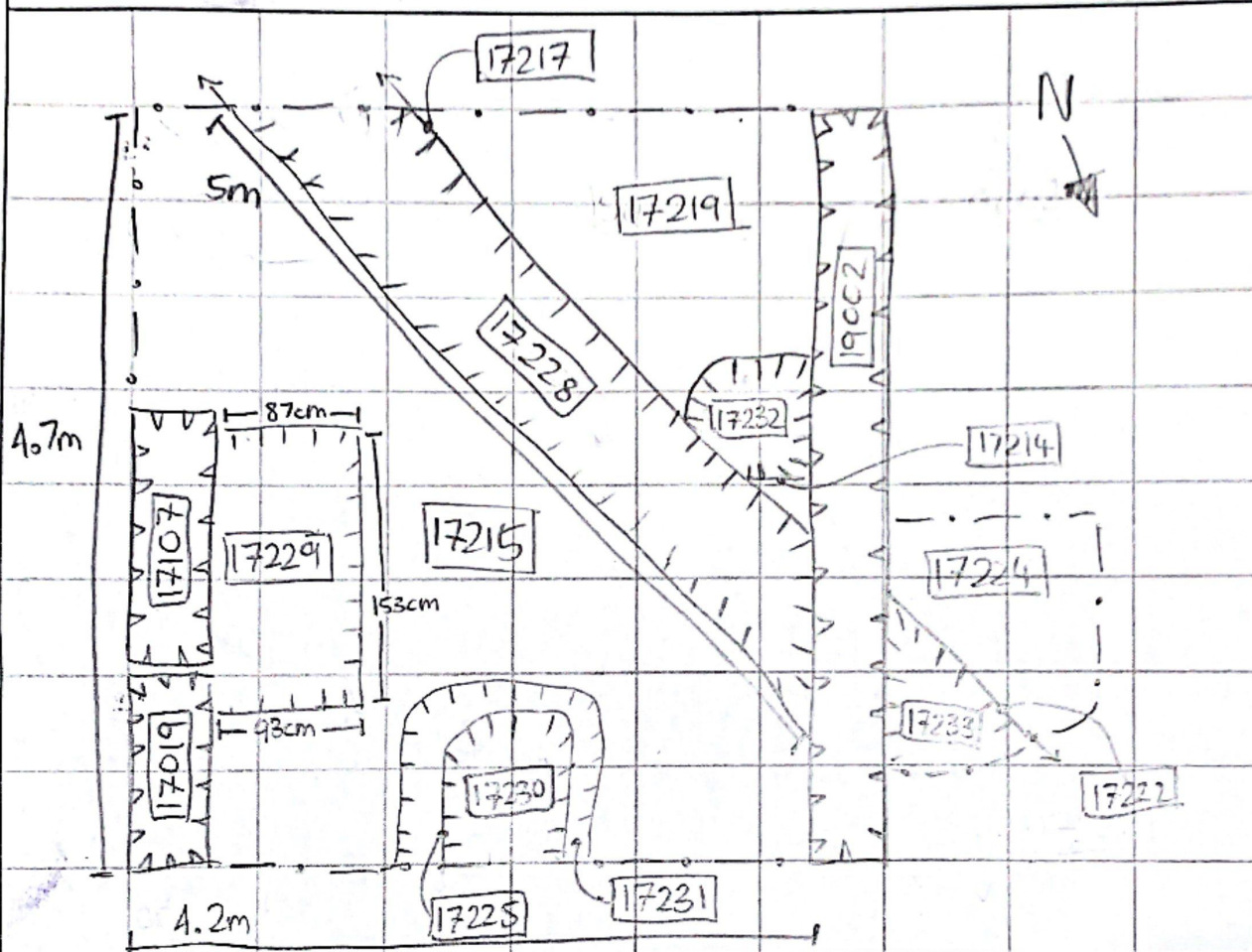

Stratigraphic relationships suggest that 17215 is a pre building surface because it is cut by 17217, which is cut by the wall, 19002.  
The forge first presented as 17216, which was covered by 17215, but underneath that the forge depression (17225) is cut into a surface below 17215, 17231.

We only excavated 17215 in a section (87cm x 153cm x 93cm) and it was dug to the natural base silty clay ('chocolate') (SU 17229), at a depth of around 12-13cm.
