INTERPRETATION/DISCUSSION:
 Approx 3cm taken off after ruspa. Mixed friable soil. In the SE came down on RPP 10000 in the south, exposing the stone pier. Previously excavated area roped off and not excavated. Once cleaning layer removed two N-S walls (SU 17002, 17012) perpendicular to opus ret. wall SU 17018. Exposed by ruspa. In the SW a column base (SU 17003), brown matrix (SU 17004), white stone collapse (?) (SU 17005) and kiln (SU 17006) revealed. In SE corner two kilns with large stones, stone rubble (wall?) on wall, a dark patch & surrounding matrix. In NW bronze found.

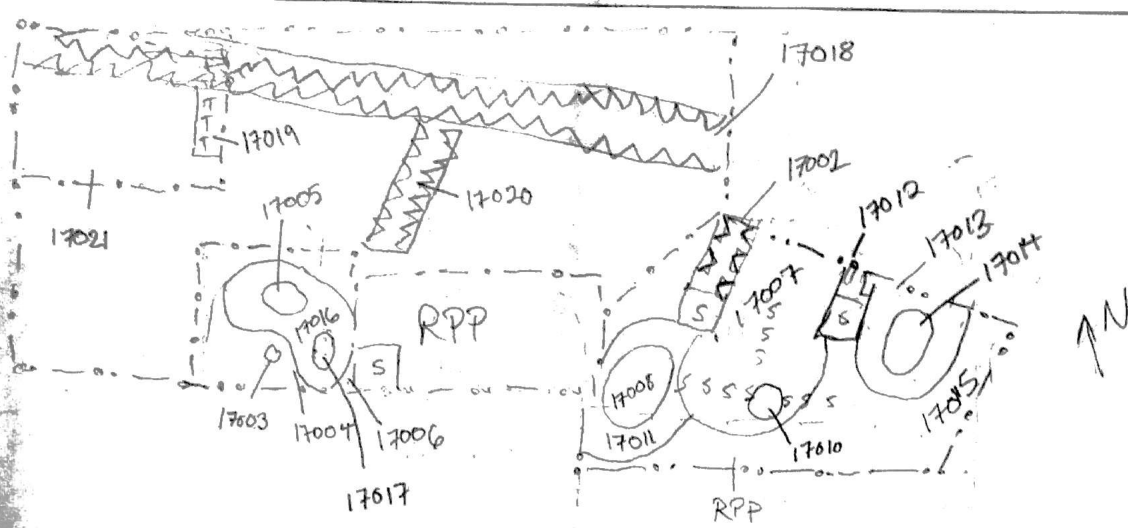
