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INTERPRETATION/DISCUSSION:
 Stone column base (ionic?); rounded base on square plinth. Carved from red conglomerate stone similar to end stones of walls in 17000 (17002 & 17012) and 16000, as well as RPP Prer (10060) — to SE and MAP prer (16036). Butted by 17027 (strange dark soil suggestive of cut around column) and 17044. Probably in phase w/ pebble surface 17052. Covers shallow foundation 17059.

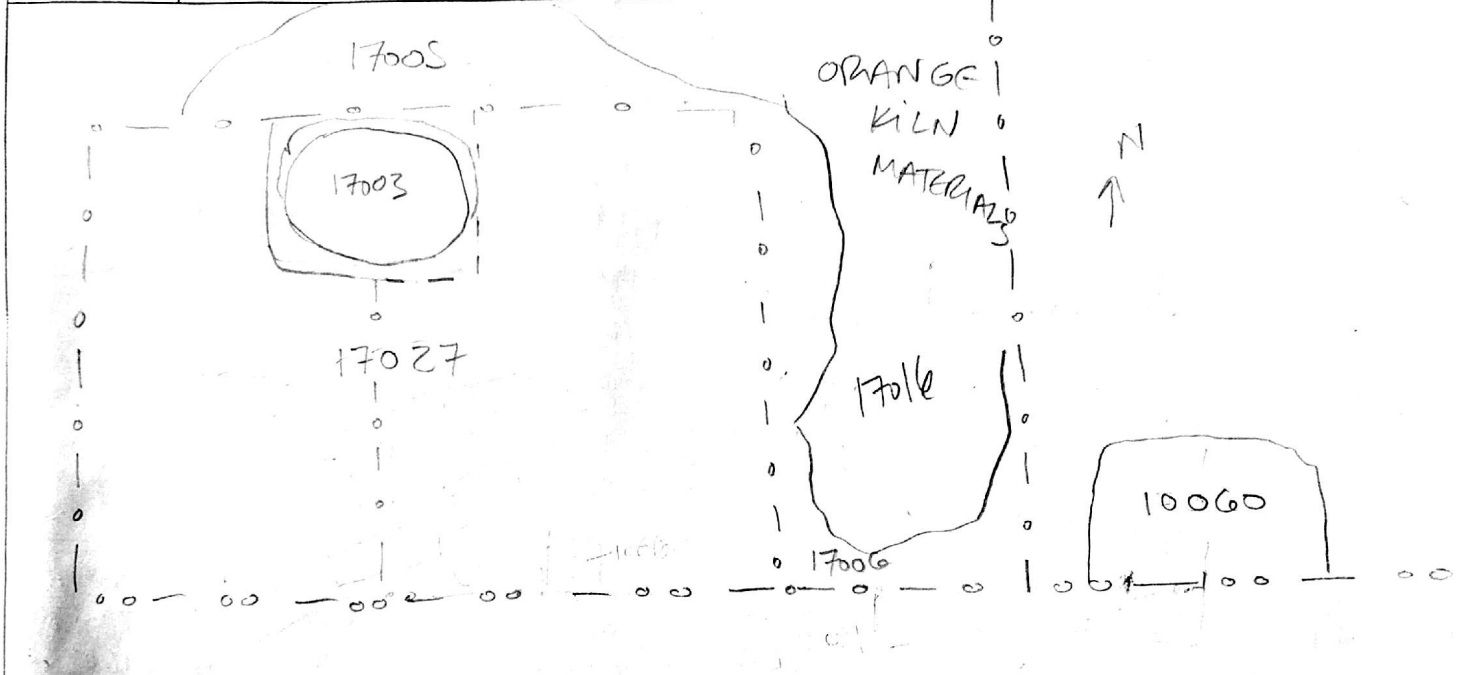
