INTERPRETATION/DISCUSSION:
 Dense Deposit of charcoal and ash full of overfired ceramic and fragments of structural materials (eg wattle & daub); fills cut 17028 originally interpreted as a kiln w/ 17011 as remains of kiln wall, but now that interpretation is questioned - How does this relate to collapse of structural materials 17011; 17054? Possible ash pit assoc w/ reoccupation of area after collapse?

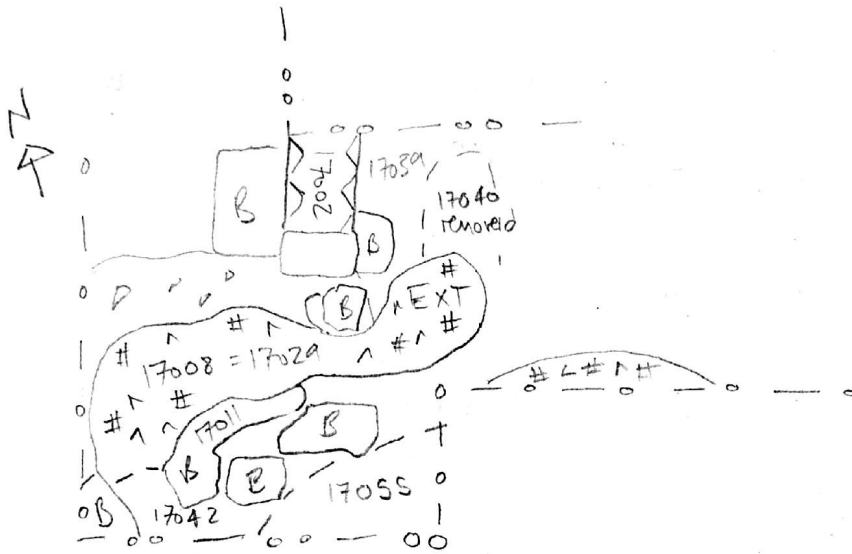
