 - once uncovered, identified as bottom half of bacino in situ, a large open vessel used often in production contexts for washing, mixing, or storage (b storage of things accessed often).
 - supported by 3 bricks (17069) to south

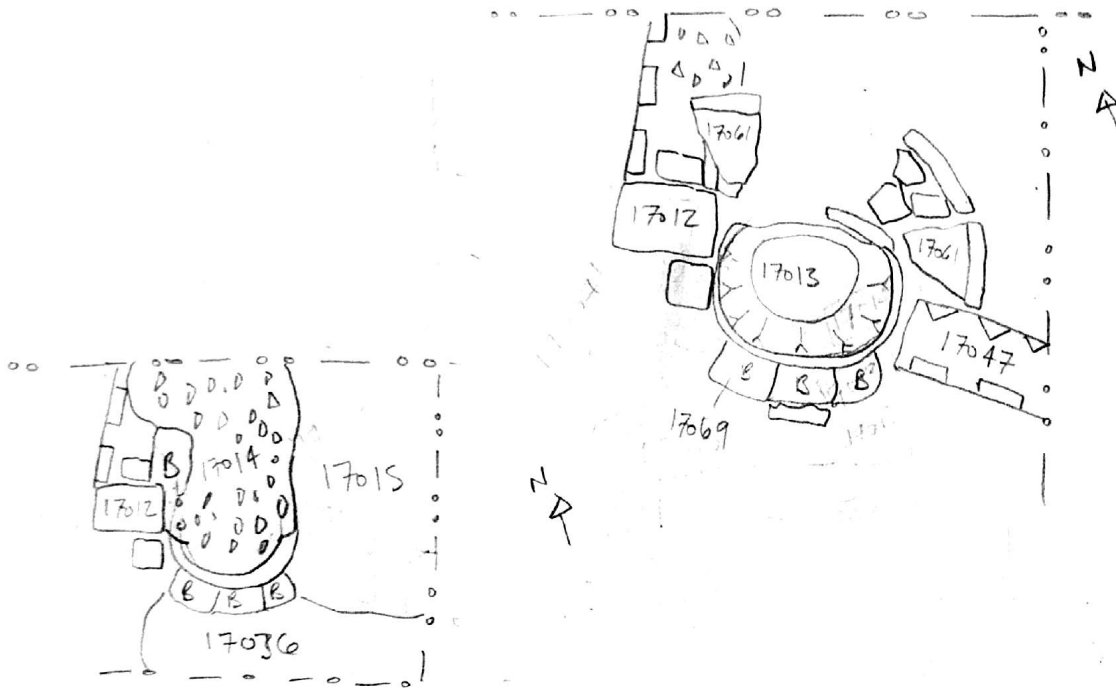
