

INTERPRETATION/DISCUSSION:
 Once 17008 and 17034 removed, revealed clay bottom, but stratigraphy showed layers not present during excavation (including a pebbled surface on the northern and southern extents of the cut.) This cut appeared to be filled with charcoal^{ash} and vessels, not all with evidence of burning.
 CUT belongs to post collapse, use phase; opening probably to the East.

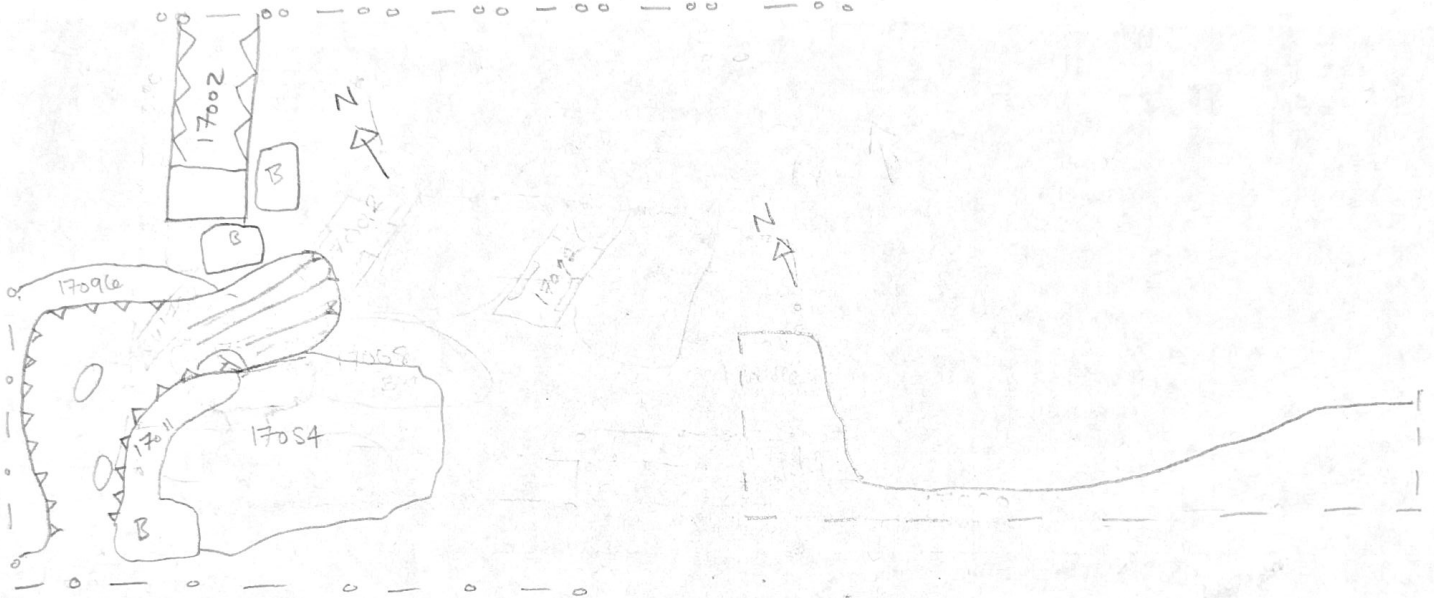
