This is a large deposit of stone & charcoal. The charcoal appears to have stained the surrounding soil during a fire event. indicative that space inside 17033 may be the combustion chamber of kiln, which was not cleared out after last firing

- Not assoc with a kiln, but probably part of fire resulting in collapse (24 July, 2001)

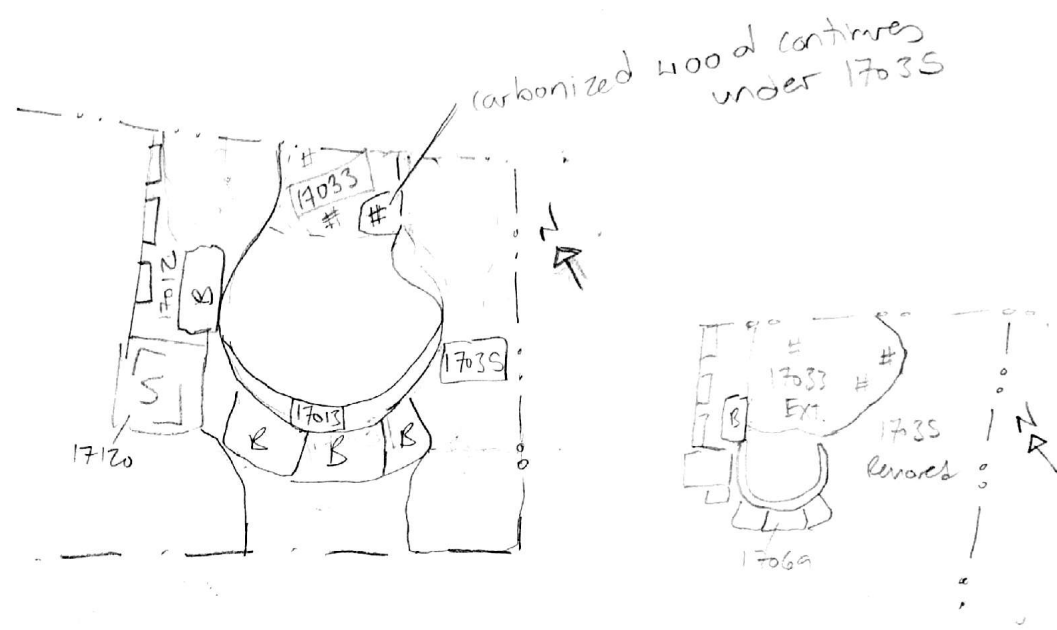
