Revised: Layer with debris from collapse of building in fire. Underneath rich charcoal layer 17008=17029. Covers amphora rich deposit to SW (17038) and patchy brown/white/black layer 17050. Part of collapse phase. (RGV)

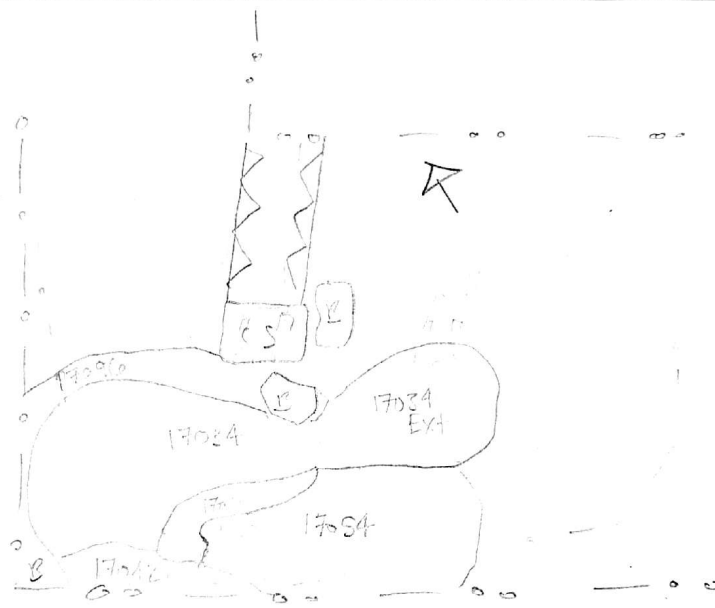
